Directions and Parking

Coaches:

Falaise Road Car Park TN34 1EU - Coaches can park in the Falaise Road Coach Park for up to 10 hours. Charges apply between 8am and 6pm. For more information:

Cars:

There are several disabled parking bays situated on the seafront outside the venue. Further parking is available nearby at:

Pelham Place – 250 spaces

Falaise Road – 68 spaces

Priory Street – 250 spaces

St Margaret's Road – 40 spaces

The Pier – 40 spaces

Carlisle Parade – 171 spaces

Bus

The Hastings and St Leonards area is served by the Stagecoach bus company, who run regular services around the town, as well as in and out of the area from nearby towns and villages.

Train

The nearest train stations are either Hastings or St Leonards Warrior Square.

Arrival and Departure

Please arrive at the front of the building where members of the team ready to greet you. This is also where parents/guardians will need to collect participants post-event.

Parents/guardians will not be allowed access to the dressing rooms and must collect participants from outside the building.

Props can be taken to the rear of the building in the car park and delivered to the Dance Live! Team at the venue's loading bay/stage door. This is where they should be collected at the end of the event. Please note that while vehicle access is allowed for drop off and collection of set, there is no parking available directly at the venue. Please see above for nearby local parking options.



Toilets

There are toilets available on level 5 and level 2. An accessible toilet with baby changing facilities is located on level 2 and can be accessed by a lift.

We do not currently offer a Changing Places toilet facility.

Accessibility

There is wheelchair access into the venue via a ramp to the right of the front entrance. From here there is lift access to all levels within the venue including the Auditorium, White Rock Studio and bar areas. An accessible toilet is located on Level 2.

We're happy to offer complimentary tickets for companions. As standard, our wheelchair positions and other 'Accessible Seats' come with one free ticket. Free standing seats are positioned next to wheelchair spaces for companions. For ambulant disabled/ non-wheelchair users and their companions, you can choose to sit in any area of the auditorium. Our Box Office team are happy to support you in making a decision as to where best to sit.

An Infra-Red Hearing Support System is available in the Main Auditorium only. Infra-red neck receivers are available and can be requested at the ticket office or by asking a member of the Front of House team. Please note there are limited receivers available, and they can only be used if microphones are used during the performance. Our Box Office will be able to advise you on the best available seats to ensure the best use of the system.

Guide dogs and assistance dogs are welcome in our building. If you would like your dog to be looked after whilst you are watching an event, this can be pre-arranged by getting in touch in advance. We will arrange for someone to meet you at Box Office, guide you to your seat and stay with your dog throughout the event.

Health and Safety

No bare feet in public areas e.g. café, toilets. Please wear shoes at **all times** when not performing or rehearsing on the stage.
